Criteria:

- It is required that the applicant is a Chester Heights resident and current member of the Chester Heights Civic Association for a minimum of two years.
- They must be a high school senior at an accredited high school, a U.S. citizen, and plan to attend an accredited college/university in 2018.
- The ideal candidates have made contributions to their school and community by participating in volunteer work, student government, sports, cultural clubs, etc.

Essay: Students will submit a 1-2 page essay, typed and double spaced. Please choose one of the following topics:

- Describe what you like best about living in Chester Heights and why. OR
- Write about your best memories of living in Chester Heights. OR
- Describe how you have helped or contributed to your Chester Heights community.

Include:

- Resume OR List of community and school based activities and awards/accolades
- Official GPA and SAT/ACT scores emailed from High School Guidance Office
- 2 letters of recommendation – emailed from your High School or Recommender
- Optional: Official High School Transcript – emailed from High School Office
